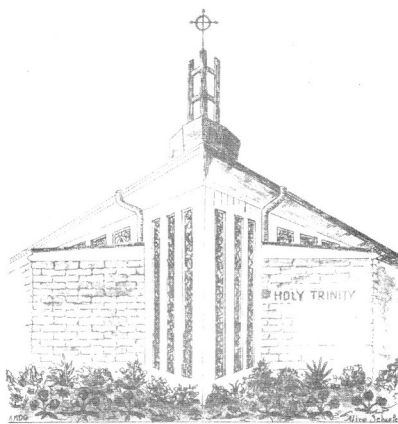

## Vision Statement

*Holy Trinity seeks to foster individual and community spiritual growth by providing meaningful liturgies, emphasizing the sharing of talents through service, educating our parish family and building a strong community to fulfill the role Christ gave the Church.*



Founding pastor, Fr. John Aylward, began celebrating Mass at Holy Trinity first at the Crazy Cat Lounge, then at a Laundromat and finally in 1960, a gymnasium /

community center was built to serve as a temporary worship space.

Fr. Walter Jaeger, the second pastor, broke ground for a school in January 1965. Fr. Edward Madden and Fr. Michael Walsh served as third and fourth pastors, both leading the parish to expand its missionary role as well as building a new sanctuary. In June 1979, two months before its 20th anniversary, the last pew was set in the new church.

Pastors since then have been:

Fr. George V. Fagan: 1982 - 1985.

Fr. Karl Useldinger: 1985-1989

Fr. John Auer: 1989-1996.

Parish Director, CoCo Soper, served from 1996-2004, with Holy Cross priests celebrating the sacraments.

Fr. Mark Zacker arrived in 2004 and was installed as pastor in 2005. Fr. Jim Williams, the current pastor and native son of Holy Trinity, began serving in February 2008.

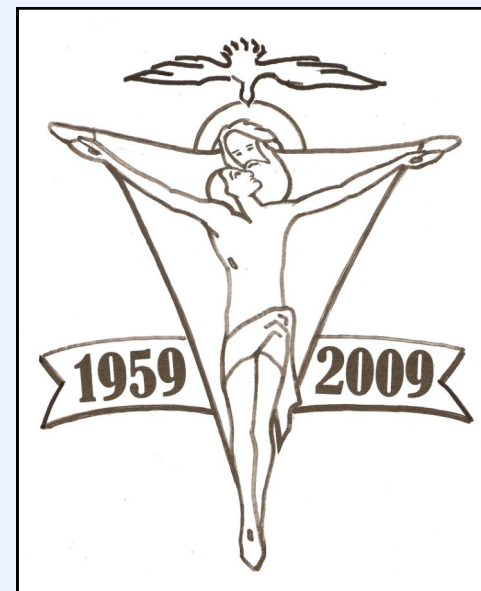

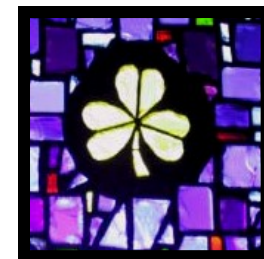
HT Parish Family Photos September
